



## Faculty of Land and Food Systems Scholarships & Awards

### MARY GRAHAM HOLLAND SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was endowed from a bequest made by the late Mrs. Mary Graham Holland. It is awarded to a female student who is entering the fourth or fifth year of study in the Home Economics program.

### C.A. ROWLES ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship established by the alumni of the Department of Soil Science to honour Dr. C.A. Rowles, Professor of Soil Science from 1946 to 1980, who also served as Head of the Department from 1955 to 1980. The award is made to the top student in third year Soil Science who will continue to completion of the B.Sc. degree majoring in Soil Science at UBC. Although decision as to the use of the award is to be that of the recipient, it is hoped that it will be used in part to broaden and enrich educational experience through such things as field studies, travel to conferences and meetings, purchase of educational materials and journals and membership in scientific societies.

### W. JACK H. DICKS SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is awarded to a student who has completed at least one year of work in the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences, who is proceeding to a higher year in the Faculty and who has given evidence of possessing those qualities necessary for community leadership.

### BRIAN K. de P. CHANCE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship created by family, friends and colleagues in memory of Brian Chance, former manager of the Douglas Lake Cattle Company. The award is offered to a third or fourth year undergraduate student in Animal Science, with preference given to students pursuing the study and breeding of beef cattle.

### B.C. COUNCIL OF GARDEN CLUBS ROSE BANCROFT SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship, a gift from the B.C. Council of Garden Clubs, is offered to a Canadian citizen entering the final year who is specializing in Horticulture in the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences. The award is made on the basis of demonstrated interest and ability in that area of study.

### GORDON ROBERT SMITH SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship, endowed in memory of Gordon Robert Smith, by Marigold Nurseries Ltd. It is offered to an outstanding student entering second, third or fourth year in Plant Science and specializing in horticulture. The award is made on the basis of a demonstrated interest and ability in commercial horticulture as shown by practical work experience in commercial or public horticulture. The scholarship is awarded on the joint

recommendation of the Director of the Botanical Garden and the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences.

### **RUSSELL FOOD EQUIPMENT LIMITED SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship by Russell Food Equipment Limited is awarded to a high ranking student majoring in Dietetics and entering the fourth year of the program. It is awarded to a student who has maintained high academic standing in the three previous years, has demonstrated personal qualities appropriate for a professional dietitian, has spent at least one University summer vacation in the dietary or food service department of an approved institution and will complete professional preparation through internship.

### **WILLIAM G. STEWART SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship, the gift of William G. Stewart, is awarded to a student proceeding into fourth year Animal Science who has achieved a high level of academic standing. Preference is given to students pursuing the study of beef cattle.

### **WESTGEN SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship that is offered by Westgen. The award is made on the recommendation of the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences to a student who is specializing in the area of animal science. Preference is given to a student with a demonstrated interest in the livestock industry. Candidates must have completed their secondary schooling in B.C.

### **WALTER D. FRITH SCHOLARSHIP**

Scholarships and bursaries that have been endowed through a bequest from the late Bessie Churchill Frith for deserving students.

### **RHONA CLARE GILLIS SCHOLARSHIPS**

Scholarships that have been endowed by the late Rhona Clare Gillis. The awards are made to students in the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences for study in practical agricultural and food production systems.

### **CHARLES AND JANE BANKS SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship was established from a bequest to the University by the late Honourable Charles A. Banks who, during his term as Lieutenant Governor of the Province, was Official Visitor of this University. This contribution provides support for worthy and deserving students and is striking evidence of the generosity of he and his wife and their concern for the welfare of others. Scholarships are awarded, on the recommendation of the Faculties, to students who have completed at least one year in the following Faculties and are continuing in the Faculty in an undergraduate program: Science, Applied Science, Forestry, Agricultural Sciences and Pharmaceutical Sciences.

### **JESSIE L. McLENAGHEN SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is awarded as a memorial tribute to the late Dr. Jessie L. McLenaghan, Provincial Director of Home Economics from 1926 to 1946. In recognition of her leadership in the development of Home Economics in this province, Dr. McLenaghan received an honorary doctoral degree from the University of British Columbia on the twenty-first anniversary of the establishment of the School of Home Economics. The award is made to an outstanding undergraduate student entering third or fourth year in the Home Economics program.

#### **DAVID A. McKEE SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship, endowed through a bequest from the late Dr. D.A. McKee, is awarded to a student in Agricultural Sciences with high standing.

#### **RUTH S. BRYSON SOROPTIMIST SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship, the gift of the Soroptimist International of New Westminster, is made available to a student entering first year in the Home Economics program.

#### **DR. ALICE RAVENHILL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship, awarded as a memorial tribute to Dr. Alice Ravenhill, is given to the student obtaining the highest standing in the second year of the Home Economics course and proceeding to the next year.

#### **JACOB AND GERTRUDE NAROD SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship was established by Mr. Milton Narod, B.S.A. (UBC), M.Sc. (McGill) and Mrs. Narod as a memorial to their parents. The scholarship is awarded to the student entering final year who stood at the head of the third year class in the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences.

#### **B.C. HOME ECONOMICS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP II**

A scholarship donated by the Home Economists in Business section of the British Columbia Home Economics Scholarships Foundation is awarded to a student entering the fourth year in either the B.H.E. or B.Sc. (Dietetics) programs. The award is made to a student who has demonstrated active participation and proficiency in the field of Home Economics.

#### **B.C. HOME ECONOMICS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS FOUNDATION – Charlotte Black Memorial Scholarship**

A scholarship donated by the British Columbia Home Economics Association Scholarships Foundation in memory of Charlotte Black, Director of the School of Home Economics at UBC from 1951 to 1965. The award is made to a student entering fourth year in either the B.H.E. or B.Sc. (Dietetics) programs who has shown proficiency in any specialty area and leadership potential.

### **B.C. HOME ECONOMICS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS FOUNDATION – Evelyn Kerr Memorial Scholarship**

A scholarship offered by the British Columbia Home Economics Association Scholarships Foundation in memory of Evelyn Kerr. The award is made to a student entering third year in either the B.H.E. or B.Sc. (Dietetics) programs. The award is made to a student demonstrating active participation and proficiency in the field of Home Economics.

### **INDRAJIT AND MANJULA DESAI PRIZE IN NUTRITIONAL SCIENCES**

A prize offered by Dr. Indrajit Desai, Professor Emeritus and Mrs. Manjula Desai. It is awarded to an outstanding student in the B.Sc. Program in the field of Nutritional Sciences.

### **J.C. “BARNEY” MacGREGOR SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is offered in memory of J.C. “Barney” MacGregor for his dedication and service to students and Faculty members in the Department of Animal Science. It is awarded to a promising and deserving student in the third or fourth year of Animal Science who displays an interest in dairy cattle production and management.

### **GEORGE J. OKULITCH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP IN FOOD SCIENCE**

This scholarship was established in memory of George J. Okulitch by his sister Olga (Okulitch) Volkoff and brother-in-law George Volkoff. George Okulitch (B.S.A. '33, M.S.A. '35) served overseas in the Second World War as a lieutenant colonel, first in the field and later as assistant military attaché in the Canadian Embassy in Moscow. He later became general manager of Dairyland and an honorary lecturer in Agriculture. The award is made to a student entering the final year in the Food Science program who has demonstrated high academic achievement.

### **C.A. ROWLES ALUMNI PRIZE**

Through the generosity of the alumni of the Department of Soil Science, a prize of \$500 is awarded to the student obtaining the highest standing each year in Soil Science 200. The award is to honour Dr. C.A. Rowles who was a Professor of Soil Science from 1946 to 1980. Dr. Rowles instructed in and contributed greatly to the development of Soil Science 200.

### **STANFORD AND IRIS WAINWRIGHT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is endowed by Iris Violet Wainwright in memory of her husband, Stanford Wainwright, and serves to recognize his general interest in the field of agriculture and his special interest in the breeding of Jersey cattle. It is awarded to a student in the third or higher year of Agriculture who has good academic standing and is pursuing studies or research in the selection of breeding of dairy cattle.

### **AGNES MERLE TURNBULL SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship, endowed by Mrs. Agnes Graham Turnbull in honour of her daughter, Agnes Merle Turnbull Porter, is offered to the highest ranking student in first year of the Home Economics program.

### **GILLMOR AND RODERICK MORRISON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship, endowed by Mr. and Mrs. A.B. Morrison as a memorial to their sons, Gillmor Innis Morrison and Roderick Norman Morrison, who attended the University during the session 1929-30. The scholarship is awarded to a student in the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences who has shown proficiency in the field of genetics and is continuing his or her studies.

### **ROBILLARD SCHOLARSHIP**

The B.C. Society of Landscape Architects provides this scholarship in memory of Raoul Robillard for a student entering fourth year in Landscape Architecture who, in the opinion of the faculty, demonstrates excellence in small scale landscape design. Raoul Robillard had a distinguished career as an early landscape architect in British Columbia and was a member of the British Columbia Society of Landscape Architects and a Fellow of the Canadian Society of Landscape Architects.

### **DAVID THOM SCHOLARSHIP**

From the funds of the David Thom estate several scholarships are available as follows: (a) for the student who has passed grade 12 with the highest standing and who is registered for the first time in the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences, (b) for the student who has satisfactorily completed the work of the first year in Agricultural Sciences and who is proceeding to a higher year in the Faculty, (c) for a student who has satisfactorily completed the work of the second year in Agricultural Sciences and who is proceeding to a higher year in the Faculty and (d) for a student who has satisfactorily completed the work of the third year in Agricultural Sciences and who is proceeding to the fourth year in the Faculty.

### **PING HUA PU SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship that has been endowed by Ping Hua Pu. The award is given to a Food Science student.

### **DR. G.F.R. BARTON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

In recognition of the private friendships, public service and contributions of Dr. G.F.R. Barton in the field of veterinary science, a scholarship was endowed in July, 1958 as a memorial by his friends in the Chilliwack area. It is awarded to a B.C. student who has good standing in the first year of the pre-veterinary course at the University and is proceeding to the next year.

### **JEAN AND MICHAEL SHAW SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship was established by Dr. Michael Shaw's colleagues and former students in recognition of his distinguished contributions to plant biology in Canada and his leadership as Dean of the Faculty from 1967 to 1975 and Vice President of the University from 1975 to 1983, endeavors in which he was ably supported by his wife Jean. The scholarship is awarded to a student who has completed at least one year in the Faculty and is proceeding to a higher year in the Faculty.

#### **WOMEN'S CANADIAN CLUB OF VANCOUVER SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship endowed by the Women's Canadian Club of Vancouver is awarded for general proficiency in the work of a third year student in either the B.H.E. or B.Sc. (Dietetics) program who is proceeding to the fourth year of that program.

#### **B.C. INSTITUTE OF AGROLOGISTS SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is offered by the Institute of Agrologists to a student entering the degree course in Agricultural Sciences for the first time. The award is made to an applicant who has a record of good scholastic standing and in making the selection consideration is given to farm background and participation in community activities. The award is made on the recommendation of the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences after consultation with the Scholarship Committee of the Institute of Agrologists.

#### **B.C. INSTITUTE OF AGROLOGISTS – DEAN BLYTHE A. EAGLES SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship, a gift of the British Columbia Institute of Agrologists, is given in honour of Dean B.A. Eagles, Dean Emeritus of Agriculture, for his outstanding contributions to the profession of agrology. It is awarded to a student who has completed at least one year in the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences. The scholarship is made to a student with high academic standing and awareness of the role of agricultural sciences in the modern world.

#### **DR. D.A. McKEE MEMORIAL PRIZE**

This prize was endowed by the late Mrs. D.A. McKee as a memorial tribute to her husband. It is awarded to the student with the highest standing in the third year of Agricultural Sciences.

#### **DEAN'S PRIZE IN AGRICULTURAL SCIENCES B.Sc. Agr. PROGRAM**

This award is given by the Dean of the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences to a student who has achieved the highest standing in courses taken in the first year of the Agricultural Sciences program.

#### **V.C. BRINK BOOK PRIZE**

This prize is awarded for outstanding achievement in the essay and other requirements as well as for leadership in the Agriculture 300 Course Field Trip. From 1950 to 1978 it was awarded as the Dean B.A. Eagles Book Prize. It was then renamed and endowed by Dean and Mrs. Eagles in honour of Dr. Vernon C. Brink, first Director of the Field Trip,

on the occasion of his retirement as Professor of Agronomy in the Department of Plant Science.
